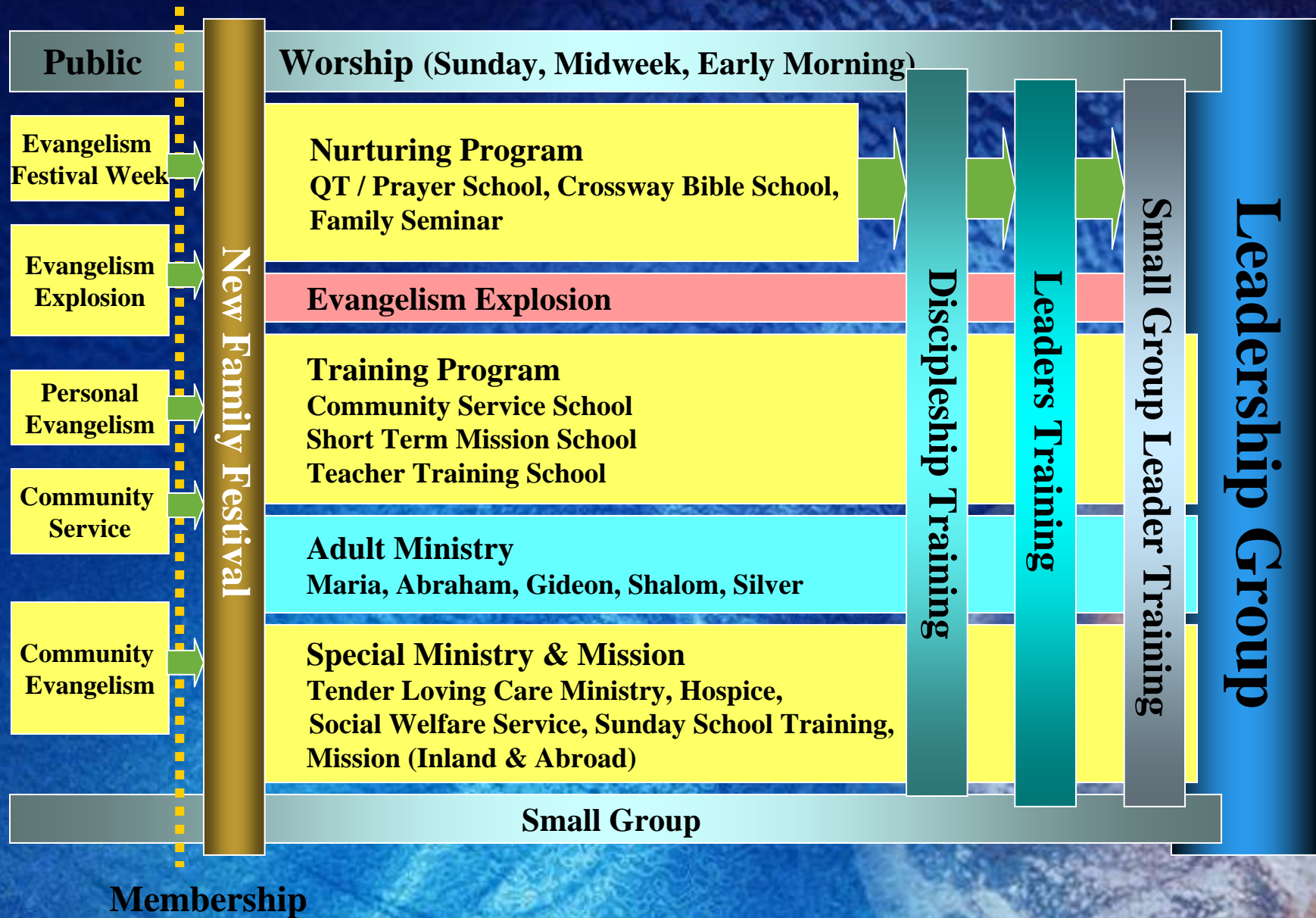

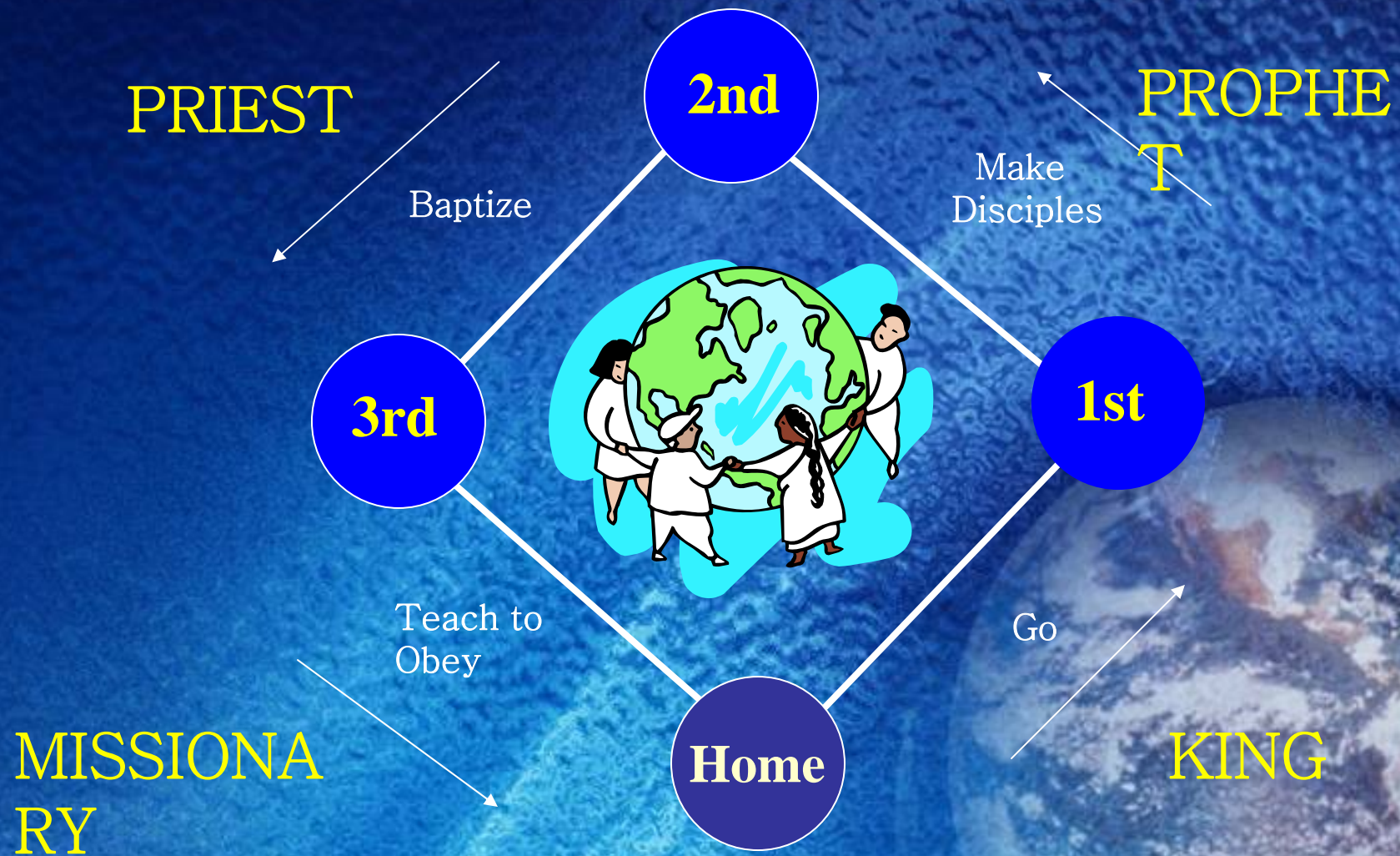


Grafting Process of Discipleship Training into an Existing Church



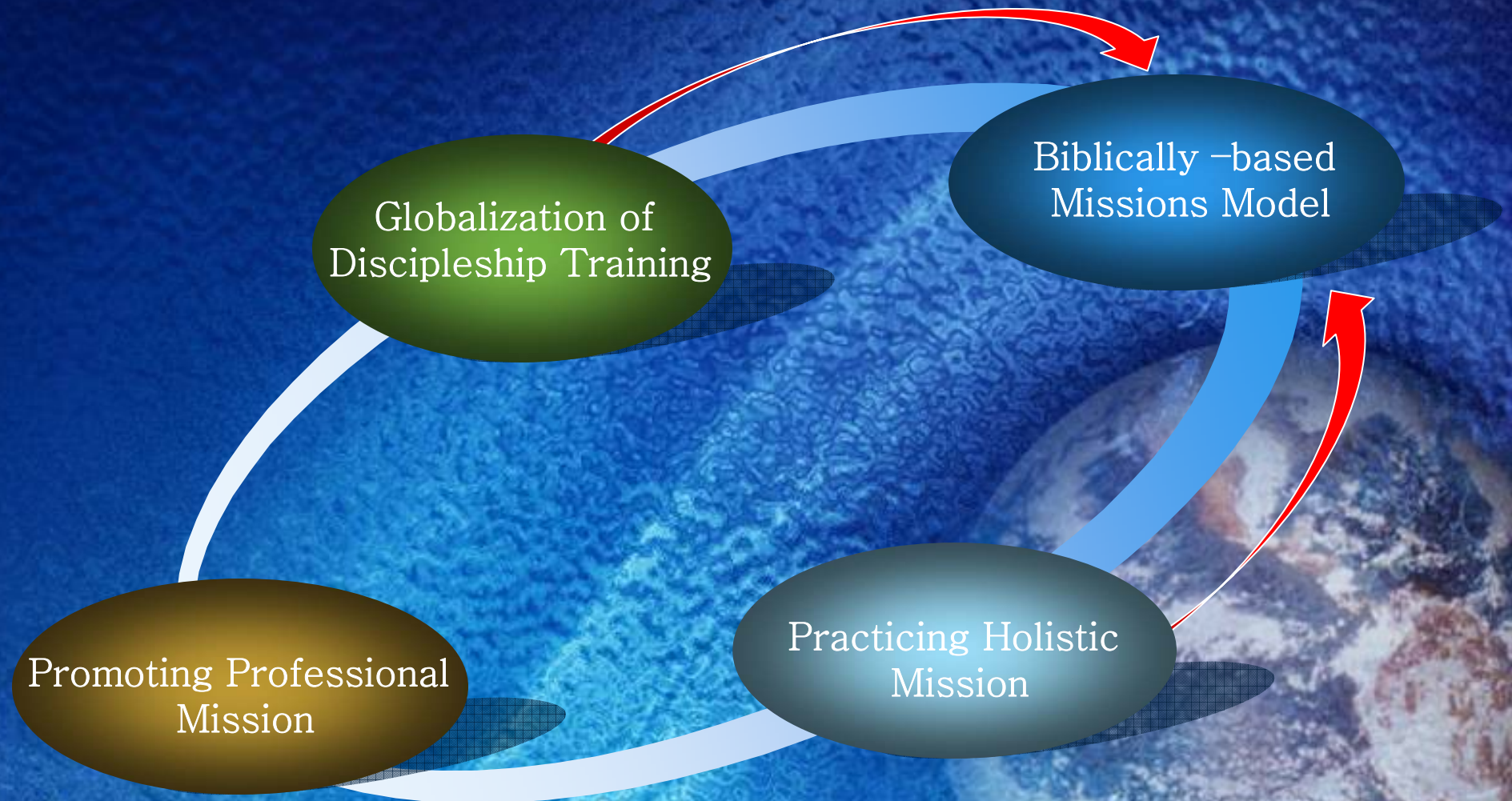

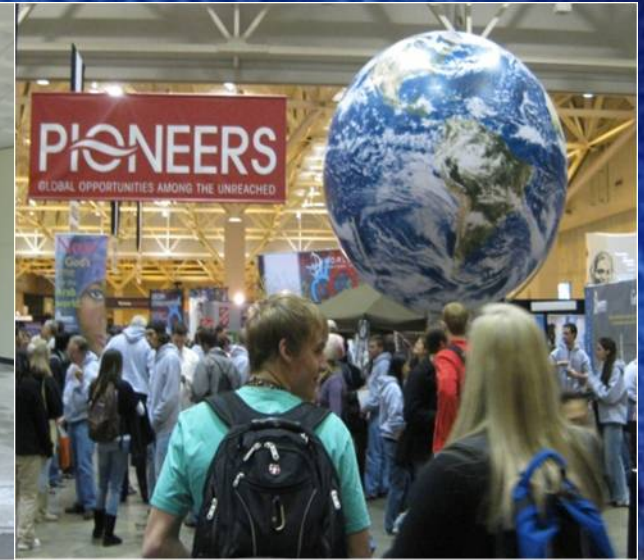

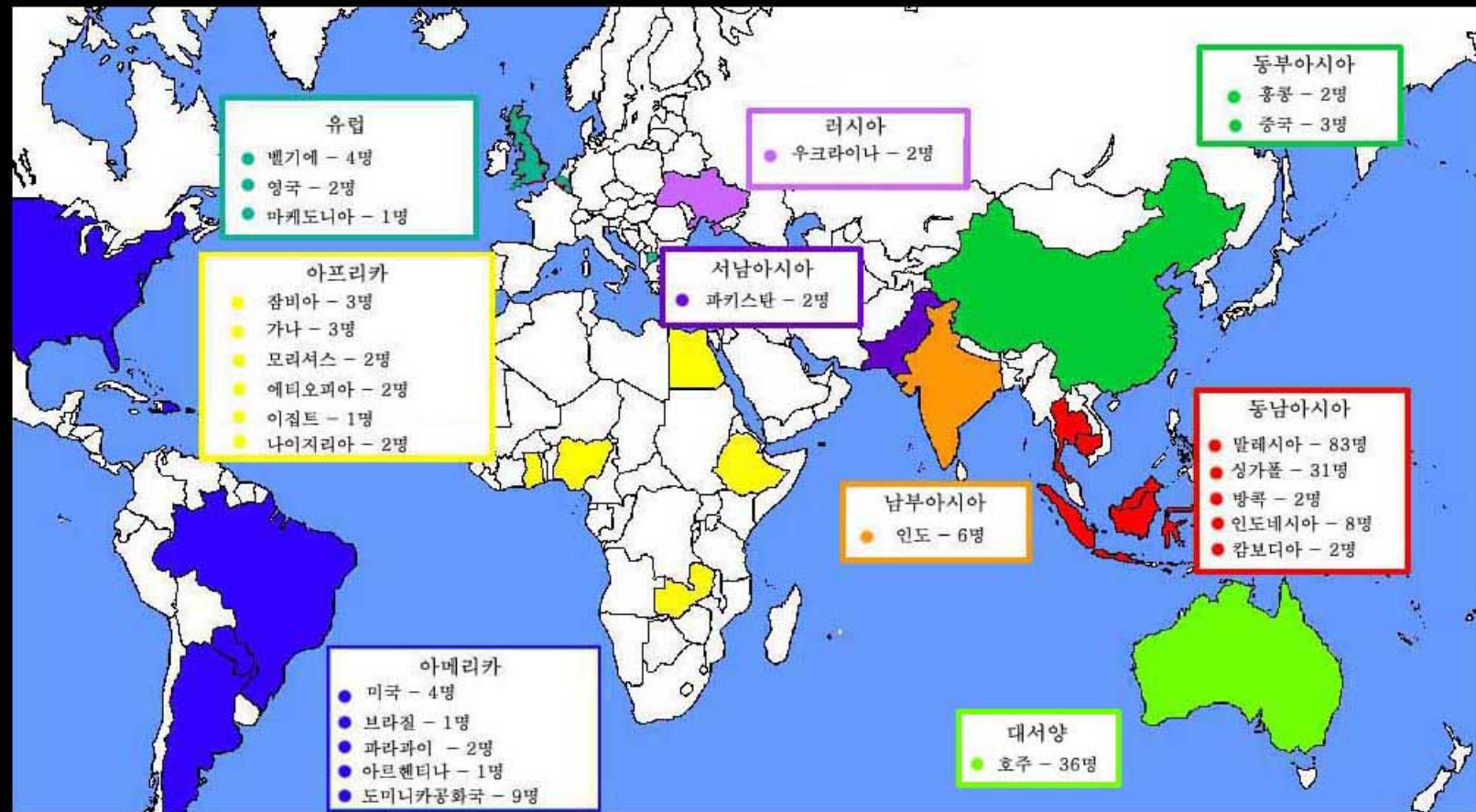
